## AT A GLANCE

---

Hostas need part shade with moist, well-drained soil rich in organic matter — not deep shade in compacted dry soil under tree roots. Their two real problems are slugs and deer. Solve those, get the moisture right, and you have a 30-year plant.

## PLANTING CHECKLIST

---

- Match site to sun requirements above before buying
- Test soil drainage — dig a 12" hole, fill with water, time it (should drain in 1–2 hrs)
- Dig hole 2x wider than rootball, same depth
- Backfill with native soil — do NOT amend the planting hole
- Water deeply at planting and weekly for first 3 weeks
- Mulch 2" deep, keep mulch 2" away from trunk/stems
